

## **Eva Schulte**

Prof. Dr. Schulte is Professor of Psychiatric Genomics and Multiomics at the University of Bonn in Germany. Here, she also leads the Clinical Division of Psychiatric Genomics and is the Director of the Center for Rare Mental Health Disorders. She trained as both a medical doctor and a natural scientist and holds specialty qualifications in psychiatry and neurology. Her research focuses on the identification and pathophysiologic understanding of genetic, lipidomic, and multiomic risk factors for mental health disorders, transdiagnostically but also specific disorders like schizophrenia and bipolar disorder. Her studies bridge scales from the individual-level to population-scale and from the cellular to the organismal level.
