

**Professor Christopher Davey MBBS(Hons) MPsychiatry PhD, FRANZCP**

Chris Davey is the Cato Chair and Head of the Department of Psychiatry at the University of Melbourne and a consultant psychiatrist at the Royal Melbourne Hospital. His main clinical and research interest is in the management of severe mood disorders. He has led large multicentre clinical trials examining psychotherapy, antidepressant medications, anti-inflammatory agents, and ketamine for depression. He is also interested in using neuroimaging to understand the brain mechanisms that underlie depression and social-affective processes.

Chris completed his medical degree at the University of Western Australia and trained in psychiatry in Sydney and Melbourne before completing his PhD at the University of Melbourne. He previously worked for many years at Orygen, Australia's leading clinical and research centre for youth mental health, and served as editor-in-chief of the Australian and New Zealand Journal of Psychiatry.
